

Shelter Island Heights Beach Club Fishing Rules

Those who wish to fish at the Beach Club should be good citizens and follow these rules:

- Fishing is permitted only after 5 pm to sunset and is limited to Heights/ Beach Club members and their guests.
- Fishing equipment should not be used from the dock anywhere within the swim rope perimeter.
- No fishing is allowed while anyone is in the water within the swim ropes.
- If someone enters the swim rope area, those fishing must reel in the line and stop fishing until no one is in the water.
- Fishing is prohibited from the bulkhead.
- No fishing is allowed while people are on the dock enjoying the sunset, sitting on the benches, etc.
- Do not leave bait or fishing equipment on the dock or at the Beach Club overnight as this attracts animals and causes unpleasant odors.
- Do not cut up bait or fillet any fish on the benches. They are not cutting boards!!

No one under the age of 13 should be at the Beach Club unless accompanied by an adult.

Please report breaches of these rules to the Heights office.

If any of these rules are violated, fishing will be prohibited at the Beach Club for all, irrespective of who breached the rules.
